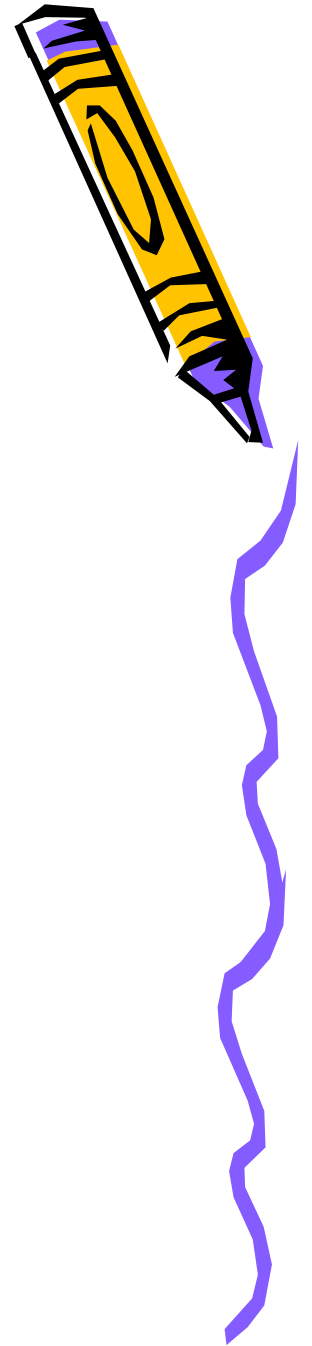
Key elements of a family-centered medical home

- Compassionate



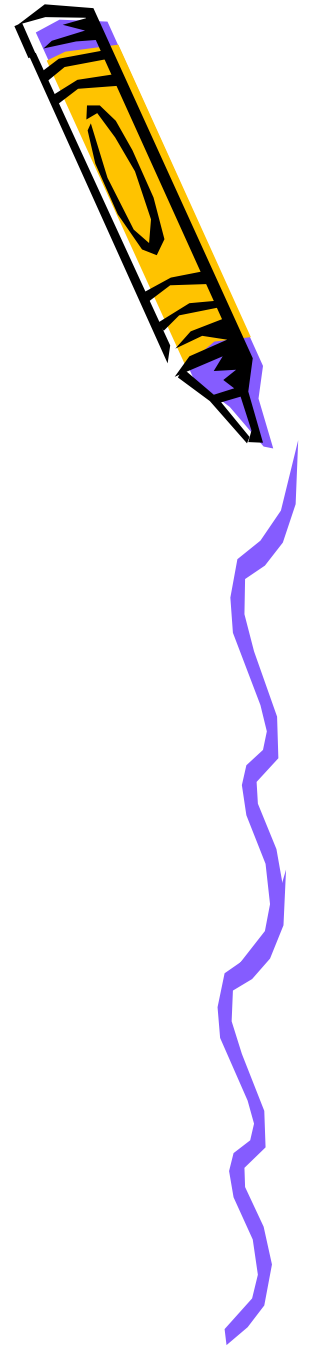
Core components

- Family participation



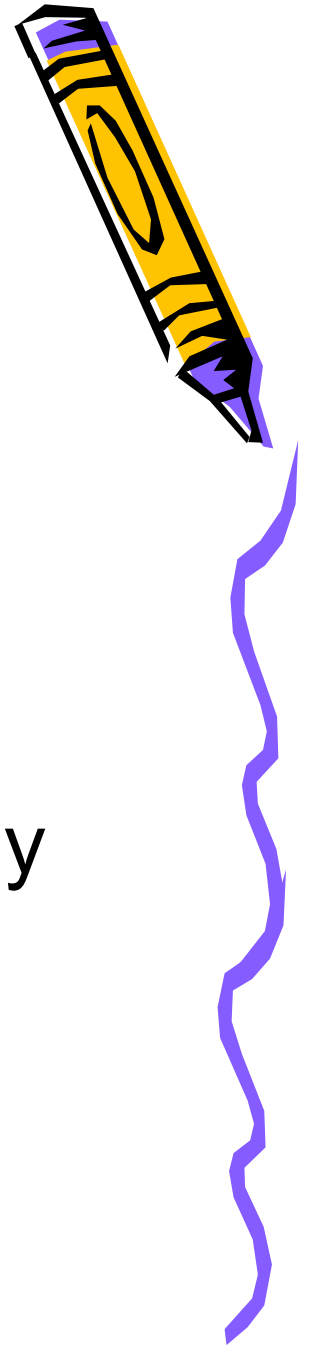

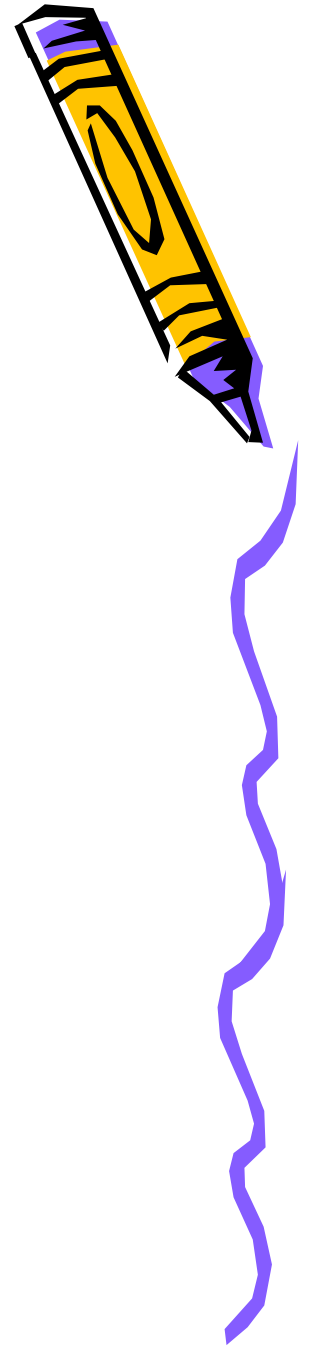
What's new at CSHCS?
